

Miller's Cabinets Customer Self Measuring Guide

- (1) Take a full size sheet of paper or graph pad and draw out your entire room as if you were looking down at it from the top. (this is called a floor plan view).
- (2) Show doorways by stopping your wall line and drawing hash marks at each side of the door.
- (3) Show windows by continuing your wall line through the window and then drawing hash marks at each side of window.
- (4) Measure each wall, breaking your measurements at each window or doorway.
- (5) Next measure from your floor to your ceiling or soffit and notate this height on your drawings. Then measure from the floor to where you want the top of your upper cabinets and notate this measurement.
- (6) Write the location of your appliances on the drawing where they are located.
- (7) Draw an outline of your cabinets on the drawing, notating any special cabinets (oven cabinets, pantry cabinets, or lazy susans)
- (8) Draw the outline of any free standing cabinets (such as an island) and notate the size of them.

That is all we will need to put together an estimate for you. Miller's Cabinets will not use your measurements to actually build any cabinets, it will only be used for bidding purposes. Upon acceptance of your quote we will schedule a time to come to your house and do our own field measurements.
